

Greater Toronto Airports Authority: Independent Board Directors



The GTAA (Greater Toronto Airports Authority) is the corporate entity which operates Toronto Pearson International Airport. The GTAA Board of Directors is comprised of a 15-member Board. Nominees are appointed by the Board for a 3 year term and can be renewed for a total of 3 terms.

The Board has an imminent need for prospective directors with functional and industry backgrounds in accounting, marketing (ideally both in business to business and business to consumer verticals) and corporate law. Prospects should satisfy most (if not all) of the following experiences and personal characteristics:
