

Airport - Threat Risk Assessment Training

Course Level: Intermediate

Description: The Threat Risk Assessment is considered a decision-making process to collect and analyze critical information from all stakeholders on a specific incident including tactical, environmental, and criminal and other related factors, yet is flexible enough to apply to any incident. The agencies' or stakeholders groups work collaboratively and function as airport security.

Requirements: It is important that stakeholders work collaboratively to respond to security incidents or convene in the command post for a threat/risk assessment. In order to conduct a practical TRA exercise it is important that all personnel, CATSA, PRP, Transport Canada, airline representatives, GTAA management and tenant personnel attend.
