ARFF Recertification 1 day IAW C.A.R.S. 323.14 (4) (b)

Pre-requisites: Certified as an Airport Firefighter

Description:

Each trainee is given 2 (two) practice runs with a certified Fire Service Instructor, where instruction on approach, positioning and agent application, is given. After each training run a debriefing is conducted with the class as a whole, ensuring that each student receives the same instruction. Once the trainee is comfortable with the vehicle, the actual Recertification run is performed. Each trainee is evaluated I.A.W. the standard GTAA ES ARFF Recertification checklist, and the results are explained after the run. Every scenario including the practice scenarios are treated as a "Response". Simulations are based on runways and aircraft commonly encountered at the trainees home airport. Training scenarios are tailored to the customer's needs.

The GTAA's Training Institute Recertification Course meets or exceeds all aspects of the Canadian Aviation Regulations 323.14 (4) Recurrent Training requirements for fire fighters.

Goals:

Except for subparagraph 323.14(2) (a) (xi) respecting live-fire training, every firefighter must complete training in each element of the standards listed in section 323.14 at least once every three years. [Course policies](#)
