Pre-requisites:

Certified Fire Fighter II and NFPA 1003 Airport Firefighter

Description:

This course is designed for airport fire departments, both civilian and military; whose primary mission is aircraft fire and rescue?

Through theory and practical training each student will learn how to safely operate an Airport fire fighting vehicle in compliance with all applicable provincial and local laws, departmental rules and regulations and standards.

The practical component of this course will focus on the maneuvering of an Airport Firefighting Vehicle through a road course that incorporates a variety of maneuvers and features you can expect to encounter during normal operations.

Goals:

The purpose of this course is to ensure a level of competency for all personnel who may be tasked with driving an Airport Firefighting Vehicle. This course shall cover the requirements for Airport Driver Operator. [Course Policies](#)
