NFPA 1003 AIRPORT FIREFIGHTER

Pre-requisites:

Certified Fire Fighter II

Description:

Designed for fire departments, both civilian and military, whose primary mission is aircraft fire and rescue. This ten-day course meets the training requirements of both NFPA 1003 and the Canadian Aviation Regulations 323.14.

The course covers such topics as; airport familiarization, aircraft rescue and fire fighting apparatus, aircraft types, engines and systems, and aircraft rescue and fire fighting procedures. These classroom sessions are followed by practical exercises on turret operations, and extinguishment of wheel/brake, engine, interior cabin, and fuel spill fires through the use of hand lines.

Goals:

The purpose of this course is to specify, in terms of performance objectives, the minimum requirements for professional service as an Airport Fire Fighter. This course shall cover the requirements for Airport Fire Fighter. [Course Policies](#)
