## NFPA 1006 ROPE RESCUE TECHNICIAN

**Pre-requisites:** Candidate must be Certified Fire Fighter or have documented proof of Hazardous Materials Awareness & Operational training; and must be an Emergency Medical Responder or equivalent and completed a Rescue Awareness course.

**Description:** This course extends the skills and knowledge gained in Rescue Awareness. This course will teach and provide the necessary skills to participate and/or lead a rope rescue operation.

**Objectives:** This course includes constructing multiple-anchor point systems, Construct a compound rope mechanical advantage system, Construct a fixed rope system, direct the operation of a compound rope mechanical advantage system, complete a assignment while suspended from a rope rescue system, move a victim in a high-angle or vertical environment, direct a team in construction and operation of a highline system, and ascend and descend a fixed rope,

**Note:** This is a very physically demanding course which requires you to be in good physical condition.

**Goals:** Upon successful completion of the training each trainee will have the knowledge, skills and confidence required to operate as a rope rescue technician. [Course Policies](#)
