NFPA 1006 Rescue Awareness:

Pre-requisites: Candidate must be Certified Fire Fighter or have documented proof of Hazardous Materials Awareness & Operational training; and must have completed an Emergency Medical Responder course.

Description: The purpose of this course is to specify, in terms of performance objectives, the minimum requirements for professional service as a Rescue technician. This course shall cover the requirements for Rescue Awareness.

Objectives: This course covers the core competencies in Chapter 5 of NFPA 1006 and includes; basic Command System, Site Operations, Manage Resources, Size up the Incident, Surveying the Incident for hazards, Managing the Incident Hazards, Conducting a Search, Victim Management, Perform ground support for helicopters, Terminating the Incident, Care and Maintenance of personal protective equipment, Scene Safety, Knots, Rigging, Constructing single-anchor points, Construct and Operate a Belay and Hauling system.

Note: This is a very physically demanding course which requires you to be in good physical condition.

Goals: Upon successful completion of the training each trainee will have the basic knowledge required to use and apply rope rescue awareness.
