Description:

The standard first aid course offered at the Greater Toronto Airports Authority fire and Emergency Services Training Institute is offered in line with St John's ambulance. This course is inclusive of the basic rescuer for cardiovascular emergencies. This qualification is good for a period of three years. It is recommended however that CPR be renewed annually.

Lessons that make up the Standard Level course are outlined below.

1. Emergency Scene Management
2. Shock, Unconsciousness and Fainting
3. Artificial Respiration (Adult)
4. Choking (Adult)
5. Severe Bleeding
6. Child Resuscitation (AR/CPR/Choking)
7. Infant Resuscitation (AR/CPR/Choking)
8. Adult CPR
9. 2 Person CPR
10. 2nd Survey
11. Injuries of the upper limbs
12. Wound Care
13. Burns
14. Medical Conditions
